The names Marius proposed for the moons in 1614 (suggested to him by a fellow astronomer, Johannes Kepler) are the ones we use today – Io, Europa, Ganymede, and Callisto.

As several moons of Jupiter are currently lost, these orbital elements may be only rough approximations. As of 2018, seven satellites are considered to be lost. These are S/2003 J 2, S/2003 J 4, S/2003 J 9, S/2003 J 10, S/2003 J 12, S/2003 J 16, and S/2003 J 23. A number of other moons have only been observed for a year or two, but have decent enough orbits to be easily measurable even in 2018.
